

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Bulk Tank Monitoring Program

Bulk milk analysis is a convenient and informative way to monitor herd health. A single bulk tank sample can provide a snapshot of current milk quality and animal health.

Evaluation of multiple bulk milk samples collected over many months can be even more informative, providing an alert to the presence of new, recurrent and periodic herd infections.

The Bulk Tank Monitoring Program provides a convenient method of moving samples from the farm to the laboratory for testing.

Samples are collected through the hauler or milk cooperative, eliminating the need for the producer to obtain and send the sample to QMPS.

Enrollment in the program entitles you to 6 bulk tank milk analyses during a 12 month enrollment period.

These are typically processed every other month.

Cost: \$200/enrollment

How does the program work?

- You pay a one time fee per year.
- QMPS collects the bulk tank sample for you eliminating the need for you to package and ship your sample to our labsites
- Samples are collected automatically 6 times a year to help track your milk quality.
- Results are reviewed and sent to you with follow-up by a QMPS representative.
- Interpretation of the results is included in the annual fee.

How much does it cost?

The cost for this program is \$200/enrollment

What information do I receive?

Your bulk tank will be cultured for the typical contagious and environmental mastitis pathogens:

Strep agalactiae Klebsiella Serratia Staph aureus E coli Yeast Pseudomonas T pyogenes Mycoplasma

In addition, the total level of strep, staph and coliforms will be reported.
