* ATTENTION: whole blood samples with hemolysis or older than 2 days are not suitable for testing. Please do not send samples for Friday and weekend delivery.

** if both IgG and IgM are being requested, 5ml serum red top is enough for both tests. There is NO need to separate serum from samples.
